

THE IMMUNOGLOBULIN E LEVEL IN NORMAL SUBJECTS AND SUBJECTS WITH ALLERGIC DISEASES

Summary

The IgE levels in the blood serum of students without history of allergy (59), the donors of 1988 and 2002 years (230), patients with bronchial asthma (192), urtikaria (93), pollinosis (100) have been studied. The normal IgE concentration has been found to be 38,9 ng/ml ranging from 0 to 371 ng/ml. A growth of the sensitization of the population, a need to determine the IgE level in the donor's blood, and the presence of a considerable number of patients with an increased content of IgE have been demonstrated.
