PATIENT WITH BRONCHIAL ASTHMA. HOW SAVE CONTROL DURING RESPIRATORY VIRAL INFECTION PEAK SEASON

The respiratory viral infection remains a main factor inducing asthma exacerbations, especially in seasonal peak of acute respiratory tract infections. The number and severity of asthma exacerbations are associated with control level. Symbicort maintence and reliever therapy (single inhaler therapy) is the most effective method to decrease risk of severe asthma exacerbations including respiratory viral infection
