

**IS WHETHER FULL CONTROL OF ASTMA ACHIEVEMENT?
THE ROLE OF THE CONSULTATION
AND DIAGNOSTICS PULMONARY OFFICE
IN THE TREATMENT OF PATIENTS
WITH BRONCHIAL ASTHMA**

Summary. *Today, bronchial asthma (BA) – is a disease with different risk factors, forecasts and different responses to treatment. Good control of asthma according to official data is achieved only in 30-50 % of cases, totally controlled asthma is in only 5 % of patients. Specialized pulmonological advisory offices are of great importance in asthma control degree increasing. Selection of the therapy, lessons with patients, increasing awareness of patients with asthma, learning correct technique of using an inhaler are directed to achieve asthma control. The appointment of combination therapy is associated with the best indicators of the asthma control degree. The use of stable fixed combination of drugs significantly increases the effectiveness of treatment and increases the degree of asthma control.*
