BRITISH RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF PATIENTS WITH ALLERGIC DISEASES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Abstract. The British Society of Allergology and Clinical Immunology has made specific recommendations for adjusting Adult and Pediatric Allergy services during the COVID-19 pandemic. These measures, aiming to provide a rational approach to reduce the risk of development of coronavirus infection and exacerbation of allergic diseases or complications during the treatment of patients, can also be applied in case of emergency to prioritize the actions of staff and patients. These recommendations can be implemented for use by Allergy services in other countries of the world, including Ukraine.
