

**EFFICACY OF
MITOMYCIN AND MITOXANTRONE
IN CHEMORADIO THERAPY
FOR LOCALLY ADVANCED
BREAST CANCER MANAGEMENT**

Summary. Usage of the combination of anthracycline-based or mitomycin and mitoxantrone chemotherapy (in cases of primary anthracycline resistance) with radiotherapy and hormonotherapy is effective and safe for locally advanced breast cancer management. These combinations increases local control and disease-free survival for comparison with radiotherapy and hormonotherapy.
