Summary. In article, patients with diseases of the cardiovascular system to complete the correction of the intravascular homeostasis, improve the rheological properties of blood, restoration of water and electrolyte and acid-base balance requires the use of drugs with immediate corrective influence on these processes. Reosorbilact application in patients with coronary heart disease can reduce blood viscosity, erythrocyte aggregation index decrease, increases the volume rate of blood flow in the microvasculature and the effect on the value of the capillary reserve. Reosorbilact advantage is its partial antiplatelet properties for along with improving hemorheological indices have prophylactic antithrombotic effect. Proved that Reosorbilact is effective for small-volume infusion therapy in patients with diseases of the cardiovascular system.
