CLINICAL COURSE, DIAGNOSTICS AND TREATMENT OF TRACHEAL BRONCHUS

Summary

Tracheal bronchus (TB) is a rare congenital pathology of tracheobronchial tree. The article deals with modern views on embryology of respiratory system, different types of congenital pathology, clinical signs of TB diagnosis and treatment. We describe 9 own observations of TB. TB had manifesting clinical course in 4 patients. In 5 cases TB was asymptomatic. The surgery was performed in 3 cases. 6 patients were treated conservatively. The results of own survey and literature data were discussed.
