PECULIARITIES OF CLINICAL COURSE
AND PATHOGENESIS AND DIFFERENTIAL
TREATMENT OF CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE
BRONCHITIS COMBINED WITH
CONCOMITANT INTESTINAL
DISBACTERIOSIS

Summary

The results of examination of 90 patients with chronic obstructive bronchitis with concomitant intestinal disbacteriosis are presented. It was determined during the examination that in 60,8 % of cases the intestinal disbacteriose corresponded to the II stage and in 39,2 % — to the III stage of gravity. The therapy with antibiotics, bronchodilators, mucolytics improved patients' health only in 27,3 % of cases. Those patients who received cycloferone and symbiter recovered and discharged from hospital earlier.
