

PECULIARITIES OF CLINICAL COURSE OF COMMUNITY-ACQUIRED PNEUMONIA WITH CONCOMITANT CHLAMYDIOSIS INFECTION

Summary

Peculiarities of clinical course of community-acquired pneumoniae have been studied. The ethiological agents of this disease were either typical pathogen (mono- or mixtinfection) or its combination with other typical pathogen. It is found out that severity of the disease and number of the days spent at hospital depended on presence of chlamidi.
