TUBERCULOSIS MORBIDITY IN FEMALES OF REPRODUCTIVE AGE IN UKRAINE

Summary

Conducted study on tuberculosis morbidity in Ukraine oblast for 2000-2005 years demonstrated that tuberculosis morbidity had been increasing each year (+8 % a year). Especially the critical situation appeared in Kherson (+89,7 %), Kirovograd (+72,8 %), Ternopil (+54,6 %) oblast, Crimean autonomic republic (+54 %). Mykolaviv (+53 %), Donetsk (+51.6 %) oblast, where morbidity during the last years raised for more than 50 %. Among the diaseased the reproductive age females (15-49 years old) dominated (66,9 %). Among them there were 52 % of females of 20-34 years of age. Impressive rates of tuberculosis epidemic among females of reproductive age for the last 5 years were registered in Crimean autonomic republic (+65,1 %), Kherson (+60 %), Zhytomyr (+59.5 %), Kharkiv (+58.1 %) and Kirovograd (+54.1 %) oblast. Unstable epidemic situation is in 21 out of 27 oblast of Ukraine.
