THE ROLE AND PLACE OF N-ACETHYL CYSTEINE IN TREATMENT OF MODERATE AND SEVERE CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE

Summaru

The results of application of N-acethylcysteine (ACC-200 by SANDOZ) in 40 patients with moderate and severe COPD for 8 weeks demonstrated an improvement of spirometry indices (FEV₁), stabilization of clinical condition, improvement of physical activity and decrease of dyspnea, decrease in exacerbations frequency in patients with severe COPD and good tolerance of the medicine.
