

# THE PROBLEMS OF INTEGRATION OF SPECIALIZED MEDICAL CARE PROGRAMS FOR DRUG-ABUSED HIV/AIDS/TUBERCULOSIS PATIENTS

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## *Summary*

A complex strategy for effective prevention, diagnosis and treatment of drug-abused tuberculosis/HIV/AIDS patients has been presented in the article. This strategy is based on integrated services in respective national programs with further creation of separate appropriate infrastructure. The authors believe that such approach would improve an adherence to the treatment, increase an access of drug-abused patients to mental care, decrease the rate of potential side effects and increase the effectiveness of preventive measures.
