Summary

A substantiation of central veins catheterization in pulmonary tuberculosis surgical patients is presented in current article. The authors' view on a problem of central venous catheter placement and the frequency of procedure in this category of patients are reflected in the report. A rationale is given for internal jugular vein catheterization as a most safe venous access.
