

**ADAPTED CLINICAL GUIDELINE:
CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE
(PART 1)**

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Abstract

Clinical guideline is a result of coordinated decision of experts, based on thorough literature data analysis and data from foreign guidelines — Global Initiative for Chronic Obstructive Lung Disease (GOLD) revisions of 2017, 2018 and 2019 years and Clinical Guideline № 101. Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. Management of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease in primary and secondary care (NICE).

Renewed definition of COPD, the approaches to classification and diagnosing, contemporary treatment options, which rely on multicenter international clinical trials data, suggesting high clinical evidence quality, are presented in this document. New principles of distribution of the patients into clinical groups, based solely on evaluation of clinical characteristics of COPD, the algorithms of initial and follow-up therapy, new recommendations for the management of exacerbations are described.

Current guideline is intended for use by all physicians — family practitioners, internal diseases physicians, pulmonologists, allergologists, cardiologist and rehabilitation specialists.
